Thank you all so much for the love and support that you have shown us since my dad's death. Thank you to so many who have sent cards and who have sent offerings to help us as well. We thank the Lord we were able to book new tickets to return to Peru on March 9th. This past month has been a whirlwind of activity getting things situated at my mom's place and preparing for our return. It has been a blessing to spend time with my sister, and also my brother, who is a missionary in Western Asia. God has been very gracious to us through all of this.

Upon our return to Peru we will have to go through the visa process all over again. We found out that for any kind of exception the paperwork has to be filled out before one leaves the country. This is good to know for the future but for the present it is disappointing news. The process is very straightforward but requires trips to the capital, Lima, and about \$800.

Pastor Daniel and the work had a good month. It is rainy season so that always makes ministry a lot more interesting. (In Peru the rain is used as an excuse why the people can't come to church). In spite of the rain they had some first time visitors this month. Kid's Club has been going good and they had an encouraging month with the new youth program. Please pray for Pastor Daniel and his wife. They have been praying for awhile whether the Lord would have them stay in Cusco or go to another area. After much prayer, he has decided to take the pastorate of The Family Baptist Mission Church in Arequipa, Peru. Pray for them as they will have a lot of added expense because they have to return to Hauncayo from Cusco and then move from there to Arequipa. They are in need of \$4,000.00 for the two different moves.

We are looking forward to being back in Peru and getting busy in the work again. Pastor Daniel and his family, as well as another missionary family who were helping us, both feel the Lord leading them to move on to different ministries. Obviously, this leaves a void for us. Pray that God would give us Peruvian men and women to train and to fill this void. Please remember to pray for us a week from now, March 9th, as we return to Peru. Thank you all!
